Hedge Laying

Bill Hartley has got going on the next phase of hedge laying. Like this time last year, it looks a bit drastic, but will shoot up very quickly once things start to grow.

Hedge laying is an art that is both ancient and environmentally friendly, not least because the dense hedges it creates provide a vital habitat for wildlife (small mammals, birds, butterflies and invertebrates) that no other option can rival. A properly laid hedge needs no additional fencing, and will remain impenetrable year-round. Well done Bill, we continue to be at the forefront of conservation at Ingleton Primary School.

School Meals

A reminder that school meals will cost £2.90 per day after half term. This is 36p less per day, great value for a nutritious and tasty meal. Nut Allergy

We are a 'nut free school' due to pupils with peanut allergies. Please would you ensure that packed lunches and snacks do not contain nuts. Thank you for your understanding.

Head lice

We have had a few cases of head lice across a number of classes. I'm sure you do already, but please could you check for these little critters regularly and remind those with long hair that their bobble needs to be in their hair not round their wrist in school. Thank you.

Measles

With the increase in cases of measles in the UK, schools are being asked to remind parents of the importance of the Mumps, Measles, Rubella (MMR) vaccination both for their children and for themselves if they have no natural immunity from childhood measles. Measles is a potentially dangerous, notifiable disease which requires a 3-week isolation period. Are your family well protected?

If there is a need for us to administer prescription medication we will request that you complete a parental agreement form. Children must not bring any medicines to school.
